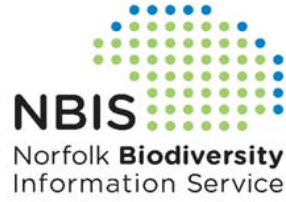

What is NBIS?

Norfolk Biodiversity Information Service collects and manages wildlife records. The centre operates on a not-for-profit basis providing information for those who are working for the conservation and enhancement of local biodiversity. Our database contains over one million species records – but we need more!

You can help us!

NBIS is always keen to receive additional records, particularly new sightings. Even records of species that are common and widespread are of use – these could become the rarities of the future! So if you have been lucky enough to spot some wildlife near your home - or when you are out and about – please tell us about it.

If you have seen something you don't recognise, please take a photograph if you can and send it to us with the other information for your record. We will pass this to the appropriate County Recorder to help with identification, and then we'll add the record to our central NBIS database.

How will your records help?

Your records will help NBIS plot the distribution of Norfolk's wildlife. We can then provide an accurate picture of the county's biodiversity so that it can be taken account of in plans and strategies. With so many development pressures on the county, the need for informed decision-making to conserve our precious wildlife has never been greater.

YOUR RECORDS

A biological record is simply a plant or animal (or fungus!) observed by a person at a location on a given date.
