**4 - 7 am**

### **Dawn Chorus**

Rise with the lark and join Norfolk RSPB Local Group on a walk taking in the sounds of the dawn chorus.

Start point: Bawsey Public Access Area. Meet at entrance off Brow of the Hill, Leziate, King's Lynn (TF 675 189)

**10 - 11.30am**

### **Birds of Reffley Wood**

Take a short stroll with Nick Acheson around this ancient woodland and discover just some of the birds that call it home.

Start point: Reffley Wood entrance, Sandy Lane, South Wootton, King's Lynn (TF 656 222)

**10.30am - 12pm**

### **Historic King's Lynn**

Imagine the sights and sounds of King's Lynn's maritime past as we explore this historic medieval port.

Start point: The Cafe in The Walks, King's Lynn (TF 624 198)

**1 - 2pm**

### **Butterflies, Bushcrickets and Bugs**

Join us on this doorstep green as we search for minibeasts that may be found living in or near Harding's Pits.

Start point: The Whale Statue, Harding's Pits, King's Lynn (TF 617 195)

**2 - 4pm**

### **Fairstead and Gaywood Meander**

This walk is based on some of King's Lynn's excellent green spaces.

Start point: The Cafe in The Walks, King's Lynn (TF 624 198)

**2.30 - 4pm**

### **In Search of Urban Wildlife**

You will be amazed at the number of different animals and plants found in a town.

Start point: The Cafe in The Walks, King's Lynn (TF 624 198)

**5.30 - 7pm**

### **A Meander on the Heath**

Take an evening stroll with us on NWT Roydon Common in search of some of the wildlife that can be found living on this amazing heath.
